## Background Note

With its past few years of experience in the field of heritage conservation and management in India, DRONAH realises the urgent need for training and capacity building programmes that should be introduced at various levels, for professionals, government organisations, non government organisations and the private sector who are stakeholders and managers of our heritage.

Management and conservation of the built heritage, natural resources, arts and crafts with community engagement requires a multidisciplinary perspective. ## Programmes Offered

### I. Heritage Management

### II. Heritage Conservation

This programme caters to architecture students, faculty of architecture schools and young professionals from multiple disciplines (including conservation architects and engineers in government and private sector, engineers in State departments of archaeology) who are involved in onsite conservation works and any interested individuals.
